If we choose to implement the WordPress platform within our Web Development team, we will be able to experience a \$2,451,000 3-year net benefit. WordPress is a website content management system that our web developers can improve their efficiency and reduce the hours completing the tasks compared with our current traditional web-based technologies. By having WordPress, we will also able to have headcount reduction in our current Web Development team.

WordPress will provide us more options for widgets and plugins. These plugins will provide us a variety of security features to make sure our information is secured. In addition, if we switch our traditional web-based technologies over to WordPress, the hours for a developer to complete the task will be reduced significantly from 100 hours to 22.2 hours.
