Our company has an opportunity to save \$3,191,000 over a three-year period by using the WordPress platform. WordPress is an online, open source website creation tool. By using this technology, 75% of the work currently being done can be done much more efficiently. By switching to WordPress, we can decrease the cost of our developers' salary to \$375,000 annually.

"WordPress is free, open source publishing software that can be installed locally on a web server and viewed on a proprietary web site or hosted in the cloud and viewed on the WordPress web site" (Rouse).
