Why Have IT Administration Controls?

- Enable the company's IT applications and data to meet business needs
- Reliable deployment of the company's IT infrastructure
- Protect the above, assuring integrity and reliability

Fundamental Administrative Controls

- IT standards, policies and procedures
- IT budget
- IT asset controls
- IT personnel management controls
- IT purchasing controls
- IT office administration controls
- Monitoring and review controls
- IT administration performance measures

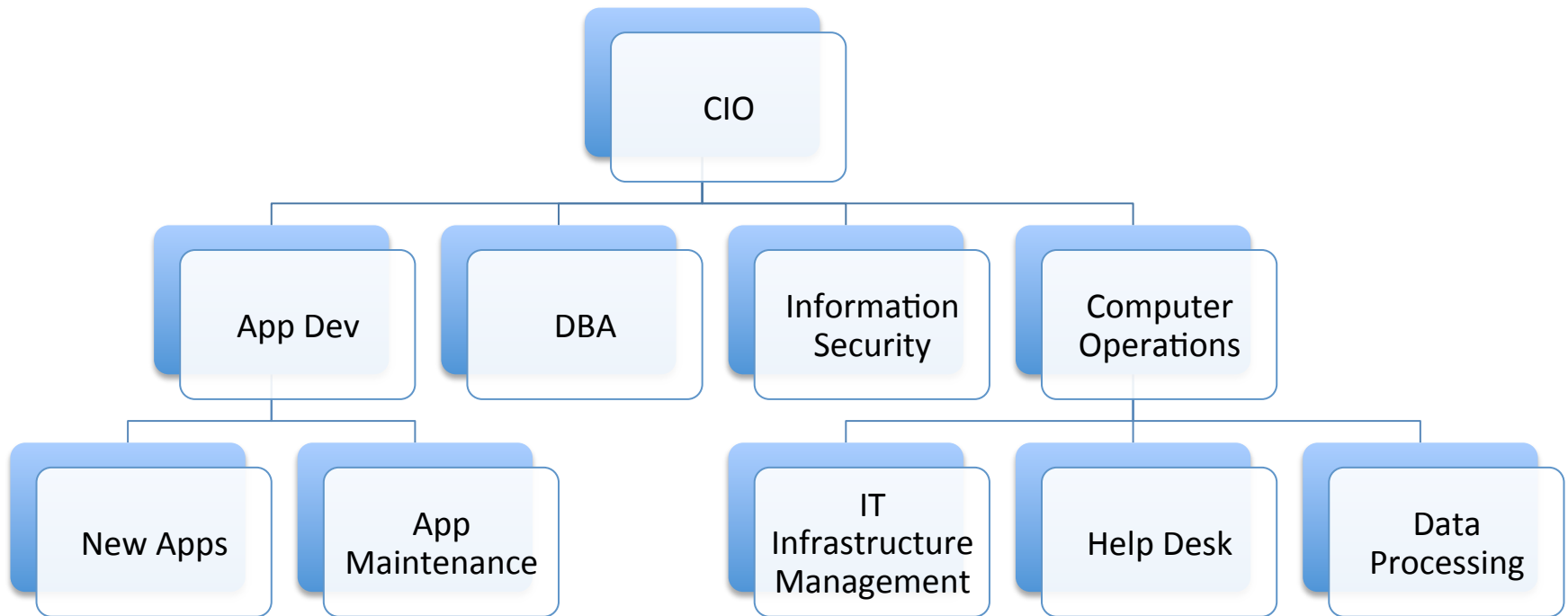
IT Budgets

- Screening

- Supervision
- Segregation of duties
