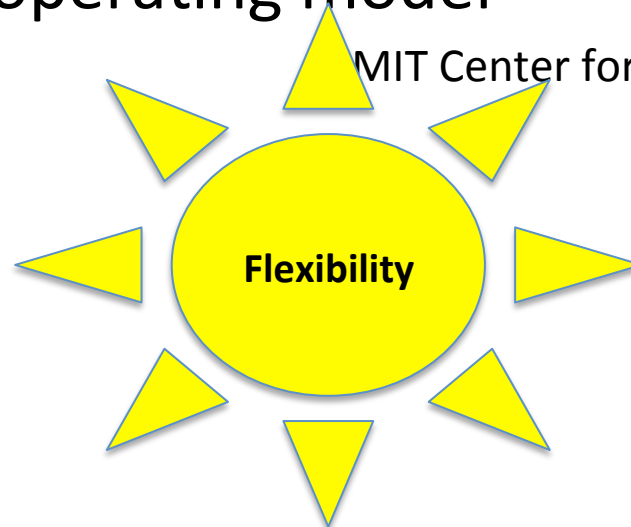
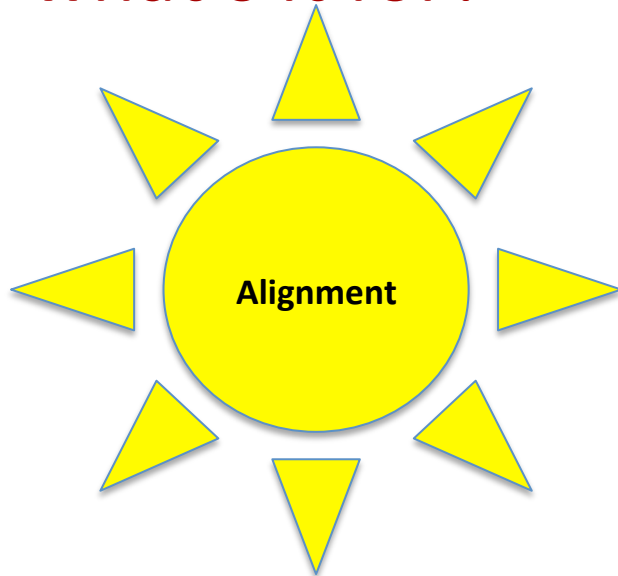
IT Strategy: COBIT APO02

EA "...is the organizing logic of business processes and IT infrastructure reflecting the integration and standardization requirements of the firms operating model"



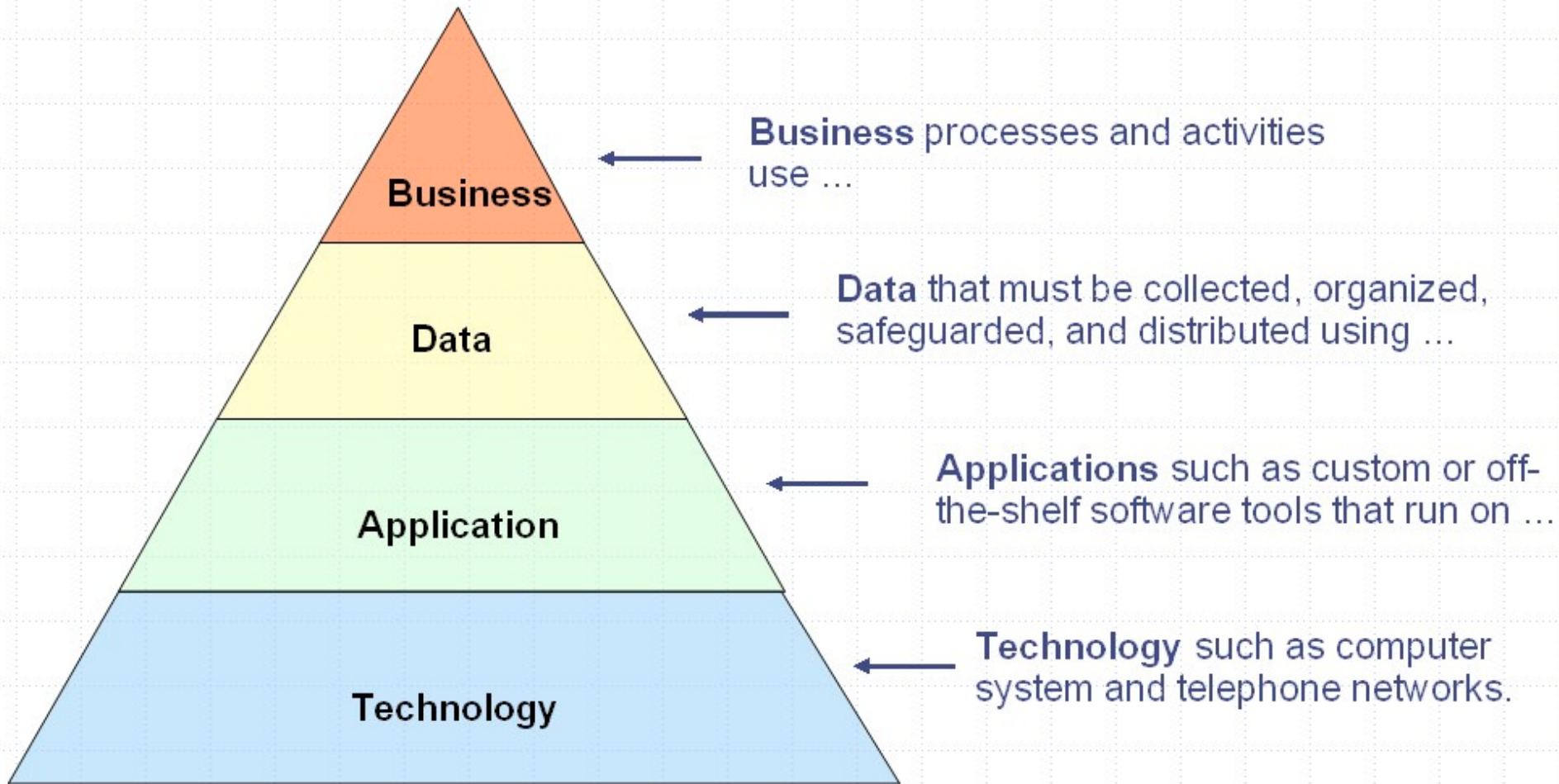

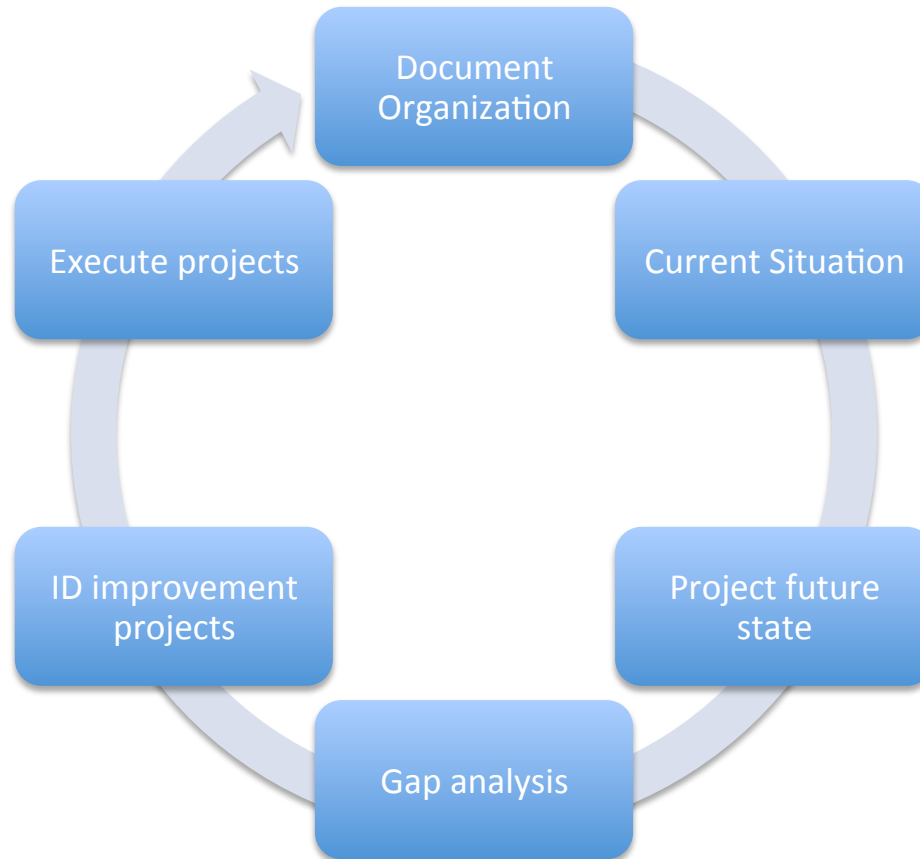
- Develop the enterprise architecture vision
