
#### Definitions

• Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) - the computer-to-computer exchange of business documents in a standard electronic format between business partners.


#### Where

- Computer-to-computer No people involved.
- Business Document Purchase Orders, Invoices, Banking Transactions, Insurance Data, Shipping Notice, Bill of Lading, Payments, etc.
- Standard Format describing what each piece of information is and in what format.
- Business Partners a.k.a. Trading Partners, under agreement



#### **EDI Risks**


- Transaction Authorization is the <u>biggest risk!</u>
- Unauthorized access to electronic transactions
- Deletion or manipulation of data before establishing control
- Transaction loss or duplication
- Improper distribution of transactions

#### Controls

- Enforce data standards
- Data Encryption
- Verify Authorization
- Transaction Receipts
- Reasonableness of transaction CHECKSUM, Hash Value, Verification Algorithms
  - Header Record
  - Detailed Record
