
# AIS TD Virtual Workshop 3: Installation Instruction - Visual Studio Code

### What is VS Code?

- Visual Studio Code is a source-code editor developed by Microsoft for Windows, Linux and macOS.
- It combines the simplicity of a source code editor with powerful developer tooling → and thus, it is suitable for developers ranging from beginners to experts!
