We have the opportunity to save up to \$2.4 million over three years by implementing WordPress. WordPress acts a web-based content management system to share and edit documents collaboratively throughout our entire company. With the implementation of WordPress we can expect a dramatic increase in efficiency from our developers and our overall net savings.

WordPress is a free platform that allows our developers to manipulate its user-friendly applications to organize our company's content into one access point. What used to take 100 hours to complete a task for our developers using traditional technologies, now can potentially only take 1/5 of that time with WordPress. Additionally, because WordPress is free, other top-talent developers across the globe are constantly working on creating new or updating proven WordPress specific applications.
