Accomplishments for September 23, 2016

1) We met the engineering team in-person and scheduled a weekly project meeting.

- 2) We created communication channels between the project management team and the engineers. We created GroupMe chats, a project-specific Gmail account, and a shared Google Drive folder.
- 3) We drafted a project scope, project charter, work breakdown structure, and problem statement.
- 4) The engineers sent us information about the project via an official project requirements document, their website, and their resources requirement document.
- 5) We clarified our roles and responsibilities within the project and helped the engineers realize the urgency of efficient project management.

Goals for September 23-30, 2016

- 1) Finalize the project charter and receive the engineers' signatures.

Issues:
