He modeled our organization as a "shark tank" for non-profits, which allowed them to pitch their organization's unique solutions to old problems for the chance to become a recipient of our support.






OUR WORK



WRITING IMAGE DESCRIPTIONS FOR VISUALLY ACESSIBILITY

What is an image description?

An image description is a written caption that describes the essential information in an image.

Image descriptions can define photos, graphics, gifs, and video — basically anything containing visual information.

It's sometimes referred to as alt text since the alt tag is a common place to store them.

The alt tag appears in the HTML code like this:
img src="link" alt="text goes here">

How to write a good image description?

The object is the main focus. The action describes what's happening, usually what the object is doing. The context describes the surrounding environment.



Example:

Description: Black Lives Matter sign being held in a crowd.

Object: Black Lives Matter sign Action: being held

Context: in a crowd

A concise way to add detail: A painted Black Lives Matter cardboard sign being held anonymously in a blurred out crowd in front of a stone building.
