Our company can have a net benefit of over \$1.8 million in three years by investing in SharePoint. SharePoint is a shared space to store documents that can be accessed by anyone in the company. Utilizing SharePoint will increase productivity of our team and ultimately increase revenue.

SharePoint is a software created by Microsoft to allow companies to easily access and edit shared documents by having a central location that projects can be accessed in.
